Drug: Transmucosal Immediate Release Fentanyl (TIRF); opioid analgesic

Brand Names: Abstral[®], Actiq[®], Fentora[®], Lazanda[®], and Onsolis[®]

Dosage forms: sublingual tablet, lozenge, buccal tablet, nasal spray, buccal film

FDA Indications: TIRFs are to be used to treat breakthrough cancer pain in adults who are concurrently taking other opioid pain medications around the clock.

Issues: These medications are very costly and have dangerous addiction potential, along with myriad other adverse side effects. If you are seeing any of these medications, be sure to confirm with the prescriber that the drug used is the best option for both pain relief and the overall safety and well-being of the injured worker.
